 - Paid (reimbursement) food costs for MERA Tour \$213.11
 - Balance as of May 27, 2025: \$11,419.04
 - Met with Treasurers across the state last week.
- OSWA Update Paul
 - o Discussed proposal to use "Kicker" for wildfire suppression & prevention
 - Discussed SB1061 Sen. Nash's Lumber Grading Bill
 - Passed Senate, Currently at Third Reading in House
 - o 2025 Oregon Family Forest Convention (June 18-21; Philomath)
 - Paul & Jacob planning to attend.
 - Paul mentioned that Karl Jensen is running for President-elect
 - Future OFFC may be held in eastern OR.
- 2025 NEOSWA Annual Meeting & Tour
 - o Irene has been working with folks from Top Road to plan a Fall Tour that we hope to make our 2025 NEOSWA Annual Meeting. Tentatively scheduled for Saturday, September 20th.
